Re: Sea Service Testimonial

Applicants who intend to obtain a Commercial Certificate of Competency in terms of Clause 8.1 of the Code of Practice for the Safety of Commercial Vessels (Training & Certification Manual) 14th Edition, are to provide documented evidence of sea service on vessels of the appropriate size and/or power to the level of the examination to be undertaken.

Candidates shall, prior to the commencement of the course, apply for a Notice of Eligibility and present the requested documentation. Additionally, candidates are to submit the Employment History from Jobsplus with the Notice of Eligibility application.

The Training & Certification Unit shall notify by email the candidate informing whether the requirements listed in the Training & Certification Manual have been fulfilled or not.

Candidates who do not fulfil the prerequisites stipulated in the Training & Certification Manual will not be issued with a Notice of Eligibility and thus cannot apply for the respective examination.
