

Driving Licence X - Animal-drawn Vehicles carrying of Passenger for Hire or Reward

Conditions for Good Repute and Conduct

Extract from regulation 6(3)(f) of the Use of Animals and Animal-drawn Vehicles on the Road Regulations ([S.L. 499.66](#)).

Cap. 9.	<p>(f) be of good repute and conduct.</p> <p>For the purpose of this paragraph, a person shall not be deemed to satisfy the requirement of good repute and conduct -</p> <p>(i) if he has been found guilty of committing any crime contemplated in Title I of Part II of Book First of the Criminal Code or articles 198, 199, 203, 203A, 204, 204A, 204B, 204C, 205, 211, 212, 213, 217, 218, 220, 238(a), 245, 248B, 248C, 248D of the Criminal Code;</p> <p>(ii) for such period during which he is serving a sentence of imprisonment of at least one month;</p>

	<p>(iii) for such period immediately following time spent serving a sentence of imprisonment for a term or terms of at least one month imposed on such person for a crime or crimes connected with violence committed on a person, which period shall be:</p> <p>i. of one year for sentences of imprisonment for a term of at least one month and not more than one year;</p> <p>ii. equal to the term of imprisonment for which such person was sentenced for sentences for terms of imprisonment of more than one year and less than ten years; and</p> <p>iii. ten years for sentences for terms of imprisonment of at least ten years;</p> <p>(iv) for such period immediately following time spent serving a sentence of imprisonment of at least one month, other than a sentence imposed on such person for a crime or crimes connected with violence committed on a person, which period shall be:</p> <p>i. equal to the term of imprisonment for which such person was sentenced for terms of imprisonment of less than five years; and</p> <p>ii. five years for sentences for terms of imprisonment of at least five years;</p> <p>(v) for a period equal to the sentence of imprisonment passed, when such sentence is ordered not to take effect in terms of article 28A of the Criminal Code, which period shall start to run from the date of the conviction; Cap. 9.</p> <p>(vi) for a period of one year following the imposition of a fine or fines which in the aggregate amount to at least four thousand euro (€4000) imposed in the previous twelve months on a person for a crime or crimes connected with violence or for committing a crime or crimes in terms of these regulations and the Traffic Regulation Ordinance, the Motor Vehicles Insurance (Third Party Risks) Ordinance, the Motor Vehicles Registration and Licensing Act or any regulation made thereunder, or for committing a crime or crimes in terms of the Animal Welfare Act or any regulation made thereunder; Cap. 65. Cap. 439.</p> <p>(vii) if he has been found guilty of committing any corresponding offence under any law of a country or territory outside Malta:</p> <p>Provided that when a suspended sentence is ordered by the Court to take effect, the period for which the</p>

Authority shall refuse to grant the licence in terms of the relevant paragraph hereof following such order, shall be reduced by the period, if any, for which the person has already been refused a licence by the Authority for the same offence in terms of sub-paragraph (v):

Provided further that where the applicant was less than eighteen years of age at the time of the commission of the offence the period referred to in sub-paragraphs (iii), (iv) and (v) shall not be longer than two years.

For the purposes of determining whether a person is of good repute and conduct in terms of this paragraph (f), the term "sentence" shall not include:

- (i) a probation order issued in terms of article 7 of the Probation Act or article 5 of the Probation of Offenders Act and which has been complied with by the probationer or an absolute or conditional discharge issued under article 22 of the Probation Act or article 9 of the Probation of Offenders Act which has been complied with; or
- (ii) a sentence for the commission of an offence for which the offender has been pardoned by the President of Malta in terms of article 93(1) of the Constitution of Malta; provided that this sub-paragraph shall only apply from the date on which the President of Malta has granted such pardon; or
- (iii) a sentence which is at the moment of application under appeal;
- (iv) a sentence for the commission of an offence which -
 - i. was committed before the date of publication of these regulations;
 - ii. was committed by a person who had a valid horse-drawn cab driver's tag issued to him by the Authority before the date of publication of these regulations; and
 - iii. was delivered at least five years before the date of application for the renewal of the horse-drawn cab driver's tag.
