# 9. EXAMINATION CONDITIONS

As per Part-66 Appendix II 1.11, a failed module examination may not be re-taken for at least 90 days following the date of the failed module examination.

As per Part-66 Appendix II 1.13, the maximum number of consecutive attempts for each module is three. Further sets of three attempts are allowed with a one year waiting period between sets.

The applicant shall confirm in writing (on Section 5), the number and dates of attempts during the last year and the organisation or the competent authority where these attempts took place.

The CAD will request proof of identity in the form of Identity Cards, Driving License, Airport Pass or Passport. This will be checked before the examination.

Calculators are not permitted in the exams.

Any bags have to be kept at a place not in proximity of the desks.

Mobile phones shall be switched off and put in the bag.

Starting time will be registered and taken from the clock in the room.

No extra time will be given after the exam has finished

Silence is to be preserved in the examination room at all times.

Candidates who are proven to be cheating shall be banned from taking any further examination within 12 months of the date of the examination in which they are found cheating.

Additional instructions to attendees shall be provided by the examination invigilator.
