Temporary Suspension of Medical Certificate and Removal of Temporary Suspension of Medical Certificate.

The Aeromedical Office of Transport Malta is hereby stating the procedure to be followed in cases where an EASA certified Flight, Cabin and ATCOs medical licence holder has been assessed and requires a temporary suspension of medical certificate due to reduced medical fitness.

Following alertness is made by any party about a decrease of medical fitness of a medical certificate holder and a medical assessment is conducted by the AeMC/AME, a medical report as well as form TM/CAD/0196 together with all supporting documentation are to be sent via email to the Chief Medical Assessor (CMO) if the pilot is a Maltese Part-FCL licence holder. For any other Part-FCL licence holders, all Maltese certified AMEs are responsible to send notification and documentation to the respective Aeromedical Sections of the Pilot's Issuing Licence Authority, within 3 working days from medical assessment. The AeMC/AME are to send Form TM/CAD/0196 to the medical certificate holder to inform him of his/her temporary suspension.

The AMS Unit will in turn complete form TM/CAD/0197 to inform the Personnel Licensing Section and the operator (when required).

When the medical licence holder is fit again to resume duties, the AME will again be required to conduct a medical assessment on the condition that required the temporary suspension of medical certificate and report back to the CMO or the AMS section of the issuing authority.

After reviewing the documentation received from the AeMC/AME, if in agreement with the removal of the Decrease in Medical Fitness notification, the AMS unit is to submit form TM/CAD/0198 to the certificate holder, copying the Personnel Licensing Unit of the Competent Authority of the medical certificate holder and the Operator employing the medical certificate holder.
