## Compliance

Master of any vessel within a harbour, port or within territorial waters shall:

- a) Comply with these directions and any other direction which may be given by the Harbour Master;
- b) Comply with the requirements of marine legislation;
- c) Navigate in accordance with the <u>Convention on the International Regulations for Preventing</u>
  <u>Collisions at Sea</u> published 20 October 1972, as amended.

The Master of any participating vessel within the VTS Area shall comply with the provisions of the <u>Authority for Transport Malta Act. (Cap 499)</u> and <u>Vessel Traffic Monitoring and Reporting Requirements Regulations (S.L. 499.34)</u>. The Master must:

- Give to a VTS authority each report or any information the VTS authority requires the master to provide
- Comply with each instruction for the movement of a vessel given by the VTS Authority
