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Part-66 Aircraft Maintenance Licence Basic Examinations

Introduction

An application form to sit for Part-66 Basic Knowledge examinations, AITP-L04-Appendix 2, can be obtained directly from the Airworthiness Inspectorate or downloaded from the Transport Malta website (ww.transport.gov.mt – aviation>airworthiness inspectorate> forms).

The fees for each multiple choice examination and each essay examination are respectively Euro 46.59 (Lm 20), as specified in the Air Navigation Order Schedule 16 Part II Paragraph 8(h). Some Modules include two separate examinations: multiple choice and essay.

Payment and application procedures are included in the application form.

Applications and cancellations will not be accepted within 7 days before the examination due date. Cancellations will only be accepted if the request is received in writing.

The Examination syllabus, knowledge levels and examination structure and procedures can be found in Regulation (EC) No 2042/2003 Part-66 Appendix I and II.

Examination Conditions

Before the examination starts, the TM CAD will request proof of identity from the candidates, in the form of Identity Card, Driving Licence, Airport Pass or Passport.

Answer sheet and rough paper will be provided.

Further information on examination conditions is available on the application form L04-A2 "Application for Basic Knowledge Examination".

A failed module examination may not be re-taken for at least 90 days following the date of the failed module examination. (Refer to Part-66 Appendix II 1.11)

The maximum number of consecutive attempts for each module is three. Further sets of three attempts are allowed with a one year waiting period between sets.

The applicant shall confirm in writing the number and dates of attempts during the last year and the organisation or the competent authority where these attempts took place. (Refer to Part-66 Appendix II 1.13)
