This application form must be used for vehicles registered as from 1st January 2023 onwards and must be completed in full and signed by the applicant.

Should the applicant wish to benefit from the scrappage scheme, then it is of outmost importance that the old vehicle/motorcycle to be scrapped **MUST** be registered on applicant's name before registering the new vehicle.

Applications will only be accepted for vehicles ordered by 31st May 2022 and where the Authority was notified of such order by 3rd June 2022.

This form shall be submitted at the offices of the Driver and Vehicle Licensing Unit of Transport Malta at any of the below addresses:

All applicable supporting documents listed in Section G shall be submitted.

To be eligible, an applicant must:

- Be:
 - A person;
 - A voluntary organisation that does not carry out an economic activity;
 - $\,\circ\,$ A voluntary organisation carrying out an economic activity within the meaning of Article 107 TFEU; or
 - \circ An undertaking ¹.
- Purchase a Plugin Hybrid vehicle;
- If applicant is also applying for a scrappage grant, present the destruction certificate for a Category L or M1 or N1 vehicles which have been destroyed before the date of application. APPLICATIONS WITHOUT THIS DESTRUCTION CERTIFICATE WILL BE REJECTED.

The De Minimis² state aid rules shall apply in the case of applications submitted by undertakings or voluntary organisations having an economic activity.

Filing your application DOES NOT automatically entitle you to receive the grant.


SECTION G – Supporting documents to present with application

In the case of self-employed or a cooperative society, a certified true copy of the VAT certificate.

In the case of a voluntary organisation (NGO), a certified true copy of certificate issued by the Malta Council for Voluntary Service.



Data Protection Privacy Notice

2. To whom we disclose information

- 2.1. This information will be solely used for the reasons detailed above. However there may be cases where personal information is shared with the following third parties for reasons listed below;
 - Any third party offering assistance in providing the service, including Insurance companies and Contractors responsible for the development of Vehicle Registration and Licensing or Driving Licences Applications;
 - Any law enforcement body who may have any reasonable requirement to access your personal information;
 - Third party entities responsible for the data processing and printing of relative licences.

3. Data Subject Rights

3.1. With respect to your privacy rights, Transport Malta is obliged to provide you with reasonable access to the Personal Data that you have provided to us. Your other principal rights under data protection law are:

- a. the right for information;
- b. the right to access;
- c. the right to rectification;
- d. the right to erasure;
- e. the right to restrict processing;
- f. the right to object to processing;
- g. the right to data portability;
- h. the right to complain to a supervisory authority; and
- i. the right to withdraw consent.
- 3.2. If you wish to access or amend any Personal Data we hold about you, or to request that we delete any information about you, you may contact us by sending a request to <u>dataprotection.tm@transport.gov.mt</u>. We will acknowledge your request within seventy-two (72) hours and will do our utmost to handle it promptly. We will respond to these requests within a month, with a possibility to extend this period for particularly complex requests in accordance with Applicable Law.
- 3.3. At any time, you may object to the processing of your Personal Data, on legitimate grounds, except if otherwise permitted by applicable law.
- 3.4. In accordance with Applicable Law, we reserve the right to withhold personal data if disclosing it would adversely affect the rights and freedoms of others. Moreover, we reserve the right to charge a fee for complying with such requests if they are deemed manifestly unfounded or excessive.

4. Retention period

- 4.1. Personal data will be retained for not more than 3 months from date of application should the application not be submitted complete or is rejected.
- 4.2. Once the Licence is issued, we will retain your information for as long as needed to provide you with our service, or to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes and enforce our agreements.

5. Security

- 5.1. We take appropriate security measures to protect against loss, misuse and unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure, or destruction of your information. Additionally, steps will also be taken to ensure the ongoing confidentiality, integrity, availability, and resilience of systems and services processing personal information, and will restore the availability and access to information in a timely manner in the event of a physical or technical incident. All information gathered is kept confidential and is used solely for the processing of Vehicle Registration and Licensing or Driving Licences.
- 5.2. If we learn of a security systems breach, we will inform you of the occurrence of the breach in accordance with applicable law.

6. Governing Law

All data collected in this form is processed in accordance with the Privacy Laws that include General Data Protection Regulation (Regulation 2016/679/EU) and Chapter 586 of the Laws of Malta (Data Protection Act).
