Filming in Different localities in Malta

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta notifies mariners that filming activities will take place in different locations around the Maltese coast between 30 September 2013 and 28 October 2013. Time of Filming will be between 0700 hours to 1900 hours.


H St. Thomas Bay

 Filming from land between 15 and 18 October 2013 from 1800hrs until 0600hrs of the next day


As part of the filming is at sea the exact location and date cannot be determined since this depends on the weather.

Some scenes will include an underwater explosion (just under the surface) and so mariners are to obey any instructions issued by safety boats in the area.

In view of the above mariners navigating in the indicated areas are requested to keep a good lookout and watch on VHF Channel 12. They are to cooperate with the crew, Transport Malta Enforcement Officers and Police in the area. They are to comply with instructions issued by Valletta Port Control (Valletta VTS).





