Infrastructure Malta works at Mgarr Harbour - Gozo

Reference is made to Local Notice to Mariners No. 009 of 2019 (Infrastructure Malta works in various localities in Malta and Gozo).

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta notifies Mariners that Infrastructure Malta will start works at Mgarr Harbour - Gozo (chart 7 attached) on Friday 15th February 2019.

Works at Mgarr Harbour will be done in phases as follows:

Phase 1, works on the head with a duration of 2.5 months – Section A.

Phase 2, works on berth 2 with a duration of 2.5 months once the head is ready – Section B.

Phase 3, works on berth 3 works on this part will start in October 2019 – Section C.


These works will include the use of vessels/barges/workboats and divers. Temporary shutter works over water and below sea level, as well as a silt curtain will be installed. In view of the above, a 30m safety zone around the working area is to be maintained.

Masters and operators of vessels are informed that no vessel will be allowed to berth alongside that section of the quay while works are in progress.

They are to seek information about operating restrictions from Transport Malta and coordinate with the contractors on site. Further details about these works can be obtained from Infrastructure Malta on info.im@infrastructuremalta.com.

They are also advised to keep a sharp lookout, navigate with caution and very slow speed and give the indicated areas a wide berth. They are to comply with any instructions given by Valletta Port Control (Valletta VTS) on VHF Channel 12 and Enforcement Personnel on site.
