Subject: Guidelines for operations into conflict zones.

The purpose of this OAN is to give guidelines to Operators for operations into known conflict zones. Full information is obtained from the EASA CZIB themselves published on EASA website https://www.easa.europa.eu/en/domains/air-operations/czibs.

There are currently 12 active information bulletins published by EASA on various airspaces that are recognized as conflict zones.

The general recommendations are that operators should:

- 1. Take potential risks into account when operating in the affected airspace.
- 2. Monitor airspace developments in the region and follow all available aeronautical publications, in particular airspace closures or restrictions issued by State authorities, alongside available guidance or direction from their national authorities, including information shared through the European Information Sharing and Cooperation Platform on Conflict Zones.
- 3. Ensure that a robust risk assessment is in place together with a high level of contingency planning for their operations and be ready for short notice instructions from the State authorities.

Furthermore, Operators are to:

- 1. Advise TM CAD their intention to operate in such areas through an application in Centrik.
- 2. Upload an updated copy of the risk assessment to TM CAD in same application.
- 3. Upload a copy of their insurance certificate to TM CAD in same application.

Note:

If the Operator has regularly scheduled flights into the same war zone, they can submit a monthly application to the Flight Operations Inspectorate along with an updated risk assessment and proof of adequate insurance coverage.

Please be guided accordingly.
