| Subject: Dangerous Goods Training CBTA approval and OM D acceptance. | | |

OAN 01/23 Rev 2 provides guidance for operators implementing a competency-based approach to dangerous goods training and assessment for personnel involved in the transport of cargo, mail, passengers and baggage by air in accordance with ICAO 10147.

As of 1st January 2023, dangerous goods training must be in accordance with Commission Regulation No. 965/2012, AMC1 ARO.OPS.200 which refers to ICAO Doc 9284 - Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air. The ICAO 9284 refers to 10147.

TM CAD has allowed sufficient time and given enough details to comply with this requirement therefore it is now time to ensure that all DG training programmes are compliant and OM D approved accordingly.

With immediate effect no OM D submitted for approval will be accepted unless the DG Section has been aligned with and found as CBTA compliant.

As from 15th December 2023 all operators need to be aligned with this requirement or risk having their DG SPA revoked from the OPS SPECS.

Please be guided accordingly.
