Subject: <b>Form 091 Approvals.</b>		

The purpose of this OAN is to give guidelines to operators on how to use Form 091 more effectively.

Form 091 lists those areas in the Operations Manuals that require approval from the competent authority which for 9H aircraft and AOCs is TM CAD.

Manuals are generally not approved but accepted and those areas in the manuals that require specific approval from TM CAD are listed as approved on Form 091.

This form needs to be correctly filled out and continuously kept updated. In certain approvals it is the only document that shows such approvals, for example during SAFA inspections. Where a choice of approvals is given, for example in the fuel scheme, operators are to ensure that only one selection is made and that reflecting the proposed scheme in the OM A.

All requests for manual changes requiring approval are to be accompanied by an updated Form 091 in the application in Centrik.

Copies of the last signed and approved Form 091 are to be uploaded to Centrik Depository and these, like the uploaded manuals, are to be kept up to date. Updated forms should also be available on the aircraft for inspections during SAFA/SACA inspections. These may be in electronic format.

Please be guided accordingly.
