

1. Introduction

This PEL Notice is intended as a guide to applicants when converting an Aeroplane FAA PPL, CPL, ATPL or MPL to an EASA Part-FCL PPL(A) Licence.

Bilateral aviation safety agreement (BASA) is an agreement between the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) of the United States of America and the European Union Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) which enables licence conversions to private pilot licenses (PPL(A)). Night and Instrument ratings (IR(A)), single-engine piston (SEP) land airplane and multi-engine piston (MEP) land airplane categories in single-pilot operations, excluding type ratings.

2. Requirements

Form TM/CAD/0433 shall be completed and sent to Personnel Licensing Unit on cadpel.tm@transport.gov.mt together with all the requested documentation.
