Reporting points on Arrival – Valletta VTS

- 1. Vessels approaching Grand Harbour from any direction:
 - Two (2) hours before arrival at pilot station
 - Five (5) nautical miles off from pilot station
 - At pilot station
 - When pilot embarks
 - At the breakwater
 - At berth ATA (Actual Time of Arrival)
 - When Pilot disembarks

Vessels shall remain in VHF radio communication, being ready to give a position report or inform the VTS of the vessel's intentions. Also, to take such direction or advice as the VTS deem necessary.

2. Vessels bound for Anchorage Areas / Waiting Areas or Conveyance Position:

- 2 hours before arrival to the designated area
- 5 nautical miles off from the designated area
- Prior to anchoring at the designated area or on arrival at the conveyance position (ATA)

Vessels shall remain in VHF radio communication, being ready to give a position report or inform the VTS of the vessel's intentions. Also, to take such direction or advice as the VTS deem necessary.
