1.0 INTRODUCTION

In view of the extreme tensions and new developments in Eastern Europe, Transport Malta Civil Aviation Directorate (TM-CAD) is issuing a NOTAM for Maltese registered air carriers or operators operating with Maltese registered aircraft.

2.0 APPLICABILITY

This Notice is to be disseminated to all personnel, and people who have interests relating to the safe conduct of flights in the affected region.

3.0 RECOMMENDATIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS

MILITARY INVASION OF UKRAINE BY RUSSIAN FEDERATION.

ONGOING MILITARY ACTIVITY IN UKRAINE AND ALONG BORDER UKRAINE/RUSSIA AND USE OF A WIDE RANGE OF GROUND AND AIRBORNE WARFARE SYSTEMS WHICH POSES A HIGH RISK FOR CIVIL FLIGHTS OPERATING AT ALL ALTITUDES AND FLIGHT LEVELS. MALTESE REGISTERED AIR OPERATORS AND OWNERS OF AIRCRAFT REGISTERED IN MALTA SHALL

OPERATORS ARE ADVISED TO FOLLOW ALSO RELEVANT CONFLICT ZONE INFORMATION BULLETIN (CZIB) ISSUED BY EASA AND AVOID FLIGHT OPERATIONS WITHIN THE BUFFER ZONE EXTENDING OUT TO 200NM ALONG THE UKRAINE/RUSSIA BORDER. ADDITIONAL RISK ASSESSMENT AND FLIGHT PLANNING DECISIONS SHALL BE TAKEN BEFORE OPERATING IN THE FOLLOWING AIRSPACE: MOSCOW (UUWV).
