1.0 INTRODUCTION

Following the latest developments of the conflict between Russia and Ukraine several NOTAM's and restrictions have taken place. These may not only be affecting the country specific FIR's but also neighbouring countries which may decide to impose immediate restrictions at short notice. This evolving situation should be taken into account in the safety risk assessments.
