### Fireworks Display from Manoel Island in Sliema Creek, Marsamxett Harbour

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta notifies mariners that Fireworks displays will be let off from the foreshore of Manoel Island in Sliema Creek, centered in position:

Latitude (N)	Longitude (E)
35° 54'.319	14° 30'.321

This position is shown on the attached chart. The fireworks displays will take place on the following dates and times

<b>Monday, 13 August 201</b>	<b>Between 1920 hours and 1950 hours</b>
<b>Friday, 17 August 2012</b>	<b>At 0900 hours, 1200 hours, and between 2215 hours and 2300 hours</b>
<b>Saturday 18 August 2012</b>	<b>Between 0900 hours and 0930 hours, between 1200 hours and 1220 and between 1800 hours and 2330 hours</b>
<b>Sunday 19 August 2012</b>	<b>At 0900 hours, 1200 hours, and between 1930 hours and 2300 hours</b>

Were not indicated the displays will last for 15 minutes.

In view of the above, mariners are informed that navigation within 200 meters from the above position in Marsamxett Harbour will be prohibited during the time of fireworks. All craft moored within the indicated area (as shown on attached chart) are to be removed on the above-mentioned dates and times of the fireworks displays.

Mariners are to obey directives issued by the Valletta Port Control (VTS), and by Police in the area.
