Diving Survey at Wied Buni & Qajjenza in Il-Bajja ta' Marsaxlokk

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners that a diving survey will be carried out at Wied Buni & Qajjenza in Il-Bajja ta' Marsaxlokk.

The diving survey will be carried out at Wied Buni (points A) and Qajjenza (point B), as shown on the attached chart.

A	35° 49'.212	014° 31'.848
B	35° 49'.967	014° 32'.245

The diving survey which will be held on any day between Monday 2nd March 2026 and Saturday 7th March 2026, will be carried out by divers who will be displaying the International Code of Signals flag "A".

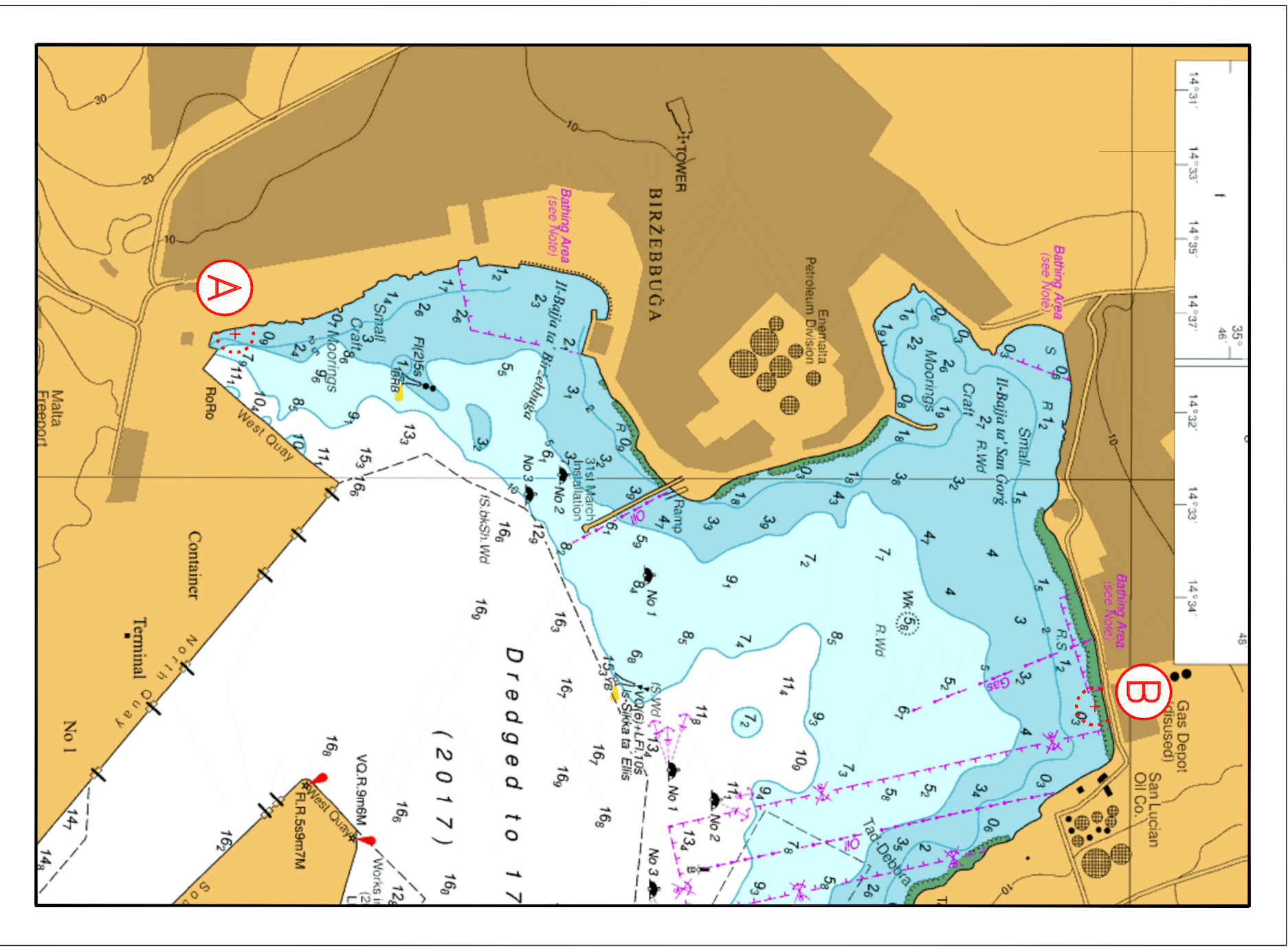
A safety distance of 30m from the above-mentioned positions is to be kept, while the diving survey is being carried out.

Vessels moored within the 30m safety distance, are to be removed during the above dates. The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta will accept no Liabilities whatsoever for any vessels that are left lying in the area on the above-mentioned dates and times.

Masters and operators of vessels are advised to keep a sharp look-out, navigate with caution and at very slow speed and give the indicated areas a wide berth.

They are also to comply with any instructions given on VHF channel **14** and/or **16** by Marsaxlokk VTS and to co-operate with the contractor on site.
