Under 18 Regatta races in the Grand Harbour - 2026

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies Mariners that Under 18 regatta races will be held in the Grand Harbour.

The regatta races will be held on Saturday 11th July 2026 from 0800 hours to 1300 hours.

The races will be held within the area formed by imaginary lines joining the points A, B, C, D and the intermediate coastline, as shown on the attached chart.

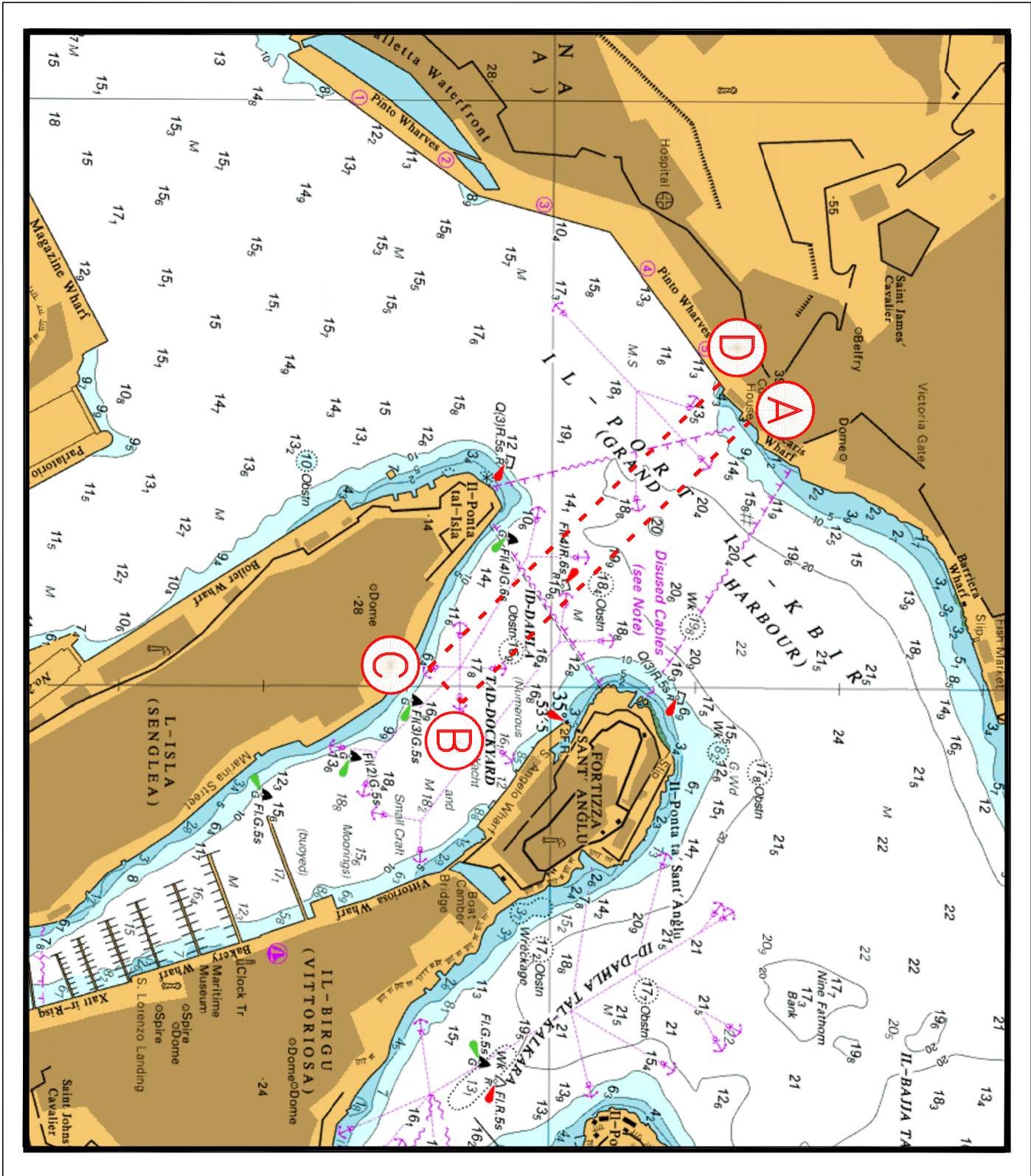
A physical line delineating the race starting line will be installed between points A and D.

If due to adverse weather conditions, the event cannot be held as planned, it will be held in the same location on Saturday 18th July 2026, between 0800 and 1300 hours.

No vessel will be allowed to enter the designated area on the above-mentioned dates and times unless granted special permission by Transport Malta.

All mariners are to cooperate with the organisers and comply with any instructions given on VHF Channel 12 and/or 16, by Valletta VTS and by any Enforcement Officers on site.
