### Regatta 2013

#### Powerboat Races in Marsamxett Harbour and Jet Skis event in Grand Harbour

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta notifies mariners that as part of the Vitoria Regatta 2013 programme the following will take place:

1. The Malta power Boat Association will be organizing power boat races in Marsamxett Harbour on **Saturday, 7 September 2013**, weather permitting.

Buoys will be laid in the following positions A and B, as indicated on chart attached:

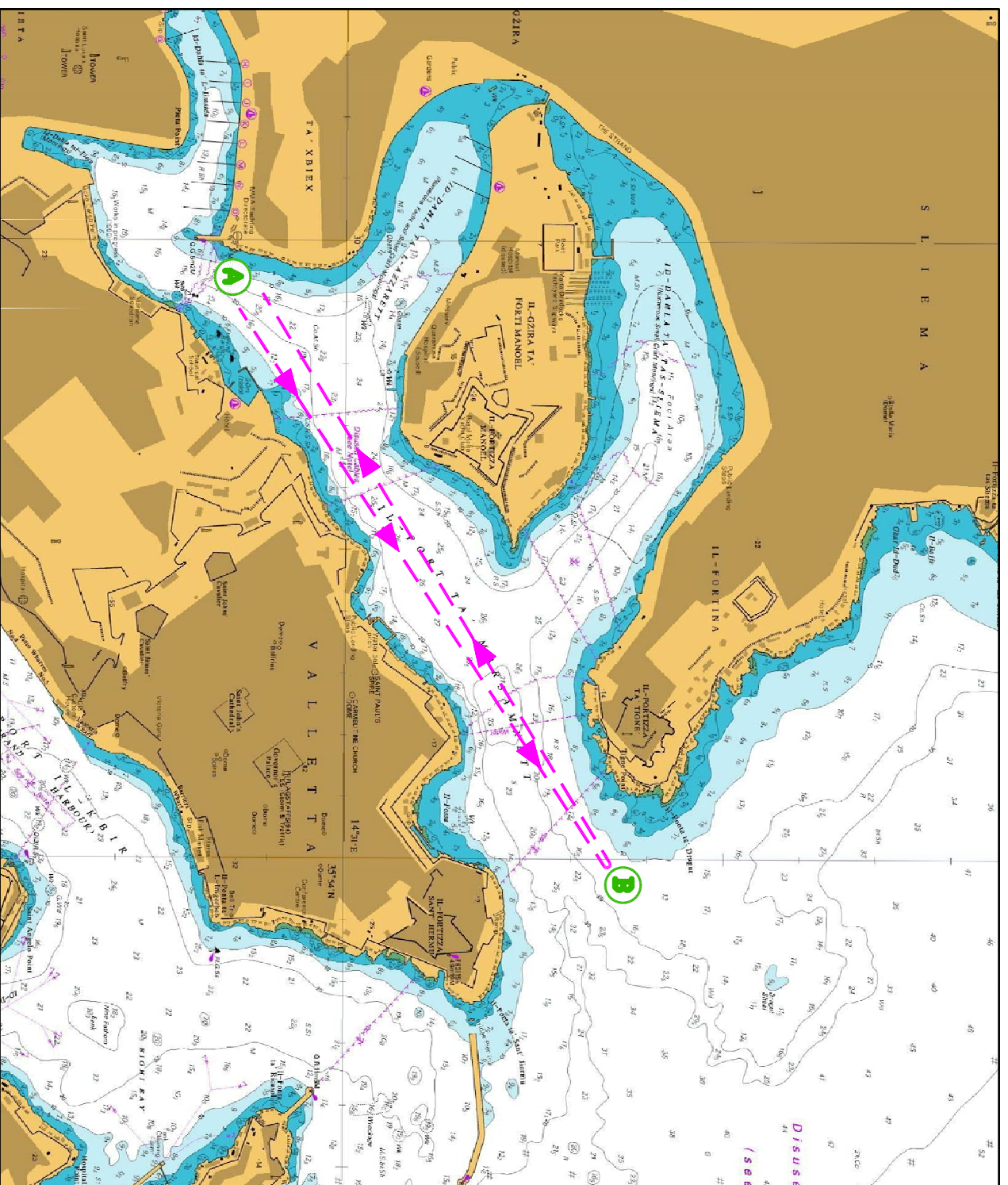
POSITION	LATITUDE (N)	LONGITUDE (E)
A	35° 53'.876	14° 30'.097
B	35° 54'.349	14° 31'.009

The timings of the race will be between 1000 hours and 1800 hours local time.

2. A jet skis show will be given in Grand Harbour which will take place at Senglea in front of the Regatta Club in French Creek. This show will start at 1800 hours and finish at 1900 hours.

Mariners are instructed not to cross the courses on the mentioned date and times stated above and that they are to give the indicated courses a wide berth. Navigation within Marsamxett Harbour will be restricted during the race. Mariners are to follow instructions given by Valletta VTS (Valletta Port Control), Transport Malta Enforcement Officers and support safety vessels in the area.
