Fireworks Display from Rinella Bay and Kalkara Creek – Grand Harbour

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta notifies mariners that fireworks will be let off from Rinella Bay and Kalkara Creek (Points A and B as shown on attached chart) on the dates and times as follows:

In Kalkara Creek from the area known as “tax-Xewkija (point A) :

Thursday 17 July 2014	From 2200 hours till 2300 hours
Friday 18 July 2014	From 2030 hours till 2300 hours
Saturday 19 July 2014	From 2300 hours till 0000 hours
Sunday 20 July 2014	From 1900 hours till 2300 hours

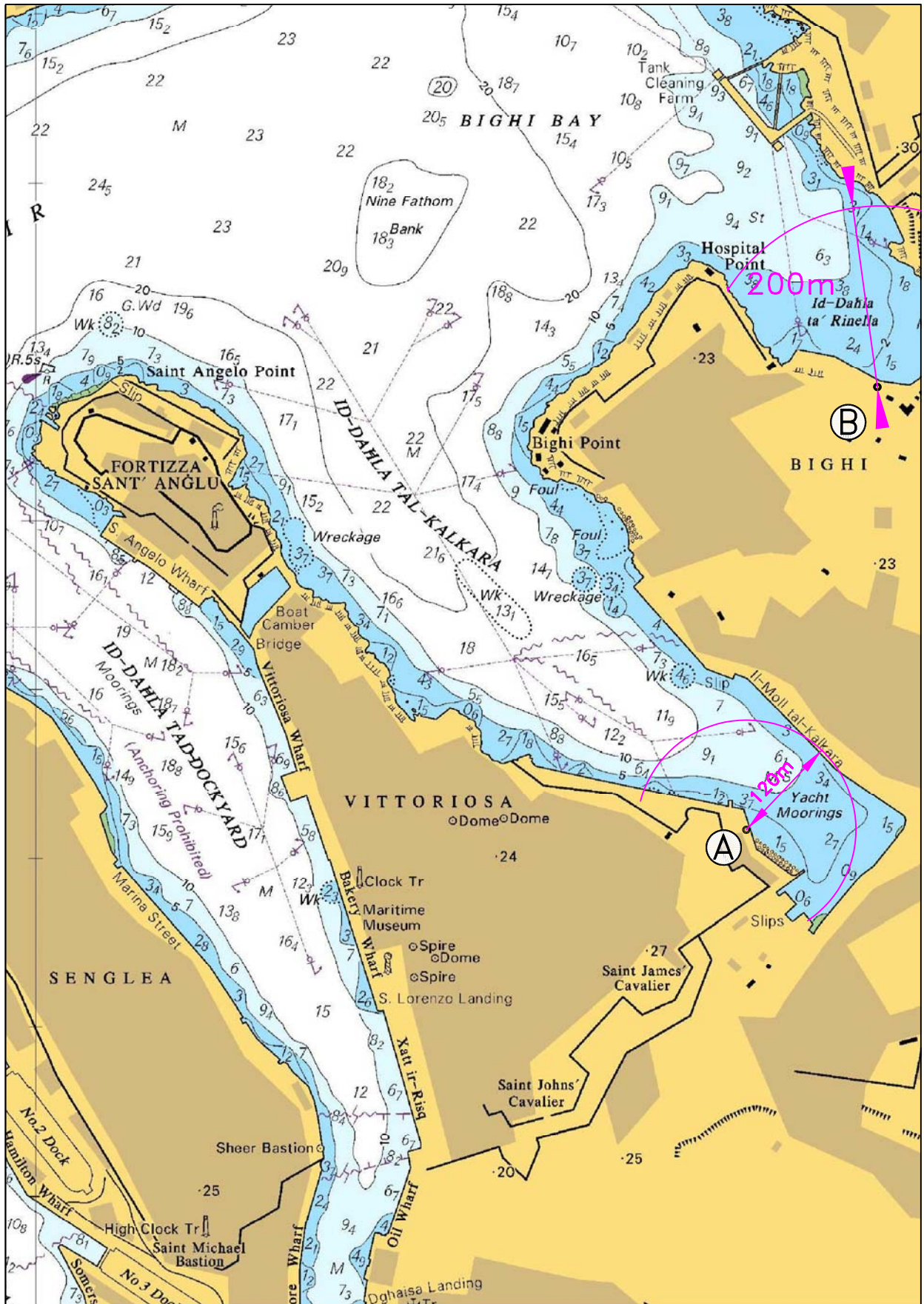
In Rinella Bay Kalkara (point B):

Wednesday 16 July 2014	From 0800 hours till 0830 hours, from 1200 hours till 1230 hours, from 2045 hours till 2145 hours and from 2200 hours till 2330 hours
Friday 18 July 2014	From 0800 hours till 0830 hours, from 1200 hours till 1230 hours and from 2130 hours till 2330 hours

In view of the above, mariners are informed to give a wide berth of 200 meters from Rinella Bay, Kalkara (as shown on attached chart point B). All Vessels within 120 meters radius from the area known as tax-Xewkija in Kalkara Creek (as shown on attached chart point A) are to be removed on the above-mentioned dates and times of the displays.

Mariners are to obey directives issued by the Valletta Port Control (Valletta VTS), and by Police in the area.
