Fireworks Displays from a Pontoon Moored in the middle of St Julians Bay

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta notifies that fireworks displays in connection with the village feast of Balluta will be let off from a barge moored in the middle of St Julians Bay. The Pontoon will be moored in position "X" (as shown on attached chart) on Friday 29 July 2016 in the morning and will be removed on Monday 1 August 2016.

The dates and times of the displays are as follows:

Friday, 29 July 2016 from 2115 hrs until 2300 hrs

Saturday, 30 July 2016 from 2200 hrs until 2330 hrs

Sunday, 31 July 2016 from 1900 hrs until 2300 hrs

All vessels and bathers are warned to keep well clear and maintain a safe distance of not less than 60 metres from the Pontoon during the above-mentioned days and times.


Mariners are to note the above and proceed with caution and at a slow speed on the given days.

The Pontoon will remain moored in position during the night.
