### Roberts Cup - Como to Malta Seaplane Rally

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies that the Malta Seaplanes Association in collaboration with Aero Club Como will be organising the Roberts Cup – Como to Malta Seaplanes Rally between **Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> December 2016** and **Monday 12<sup>th</sup> December 2016**. Part of the rally will be held in the Grand Harbour.

The flying displays over the Grand Harbour will be held on **Friday 9<sup>th</sup> December 2016** between 1400 hours and 1600 hours and on **Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> December 2016** and **Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> December 2016**, from 1000 hours to 1300 hours and from 1400 hours to 1600 hours on both days.


The displays will consist mainly of touch and go maneuvers and will be held within the area A, B, C and D, as shown hatched in magenta on attached chart. Mariners are hereby informed that during the dates and times mentioned above there will be 2 (two) seaplanes flying low in the Grand Harbour.

Valletta Port Control (Valletta VTS) will be managing the movement of vessels, on VHF channel 12.

Mariners are to navigate with caution and to keep a sharp lookout when in the vicinity to the above-mentioned area. They are to obey any instructions that are issued by Valletta Port Control (Valletta VTS), AFM Patrol Vessels and Transport Malta, Enforcement Vessels in the area.

Positions are in WGS 84 Datum.
