TROPHÉE BAILLI DE SUFFREN 2017 Classic Yachts Sailing Race

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta notifies Mariners that the Royal Malta Yacht Club will be holding a Classic Yachts Sailing Race departing Trapani on Sunday 2nd July 2017 at 1200 hours and finishing off Mgarr Gozo between Monday 3rd July 2017 and Wednesday 5th July 2017.

The finish is the imaginary line between 2 (two) inflatable lit yellow buoys placed in positions A and B (as shown on attached chart)

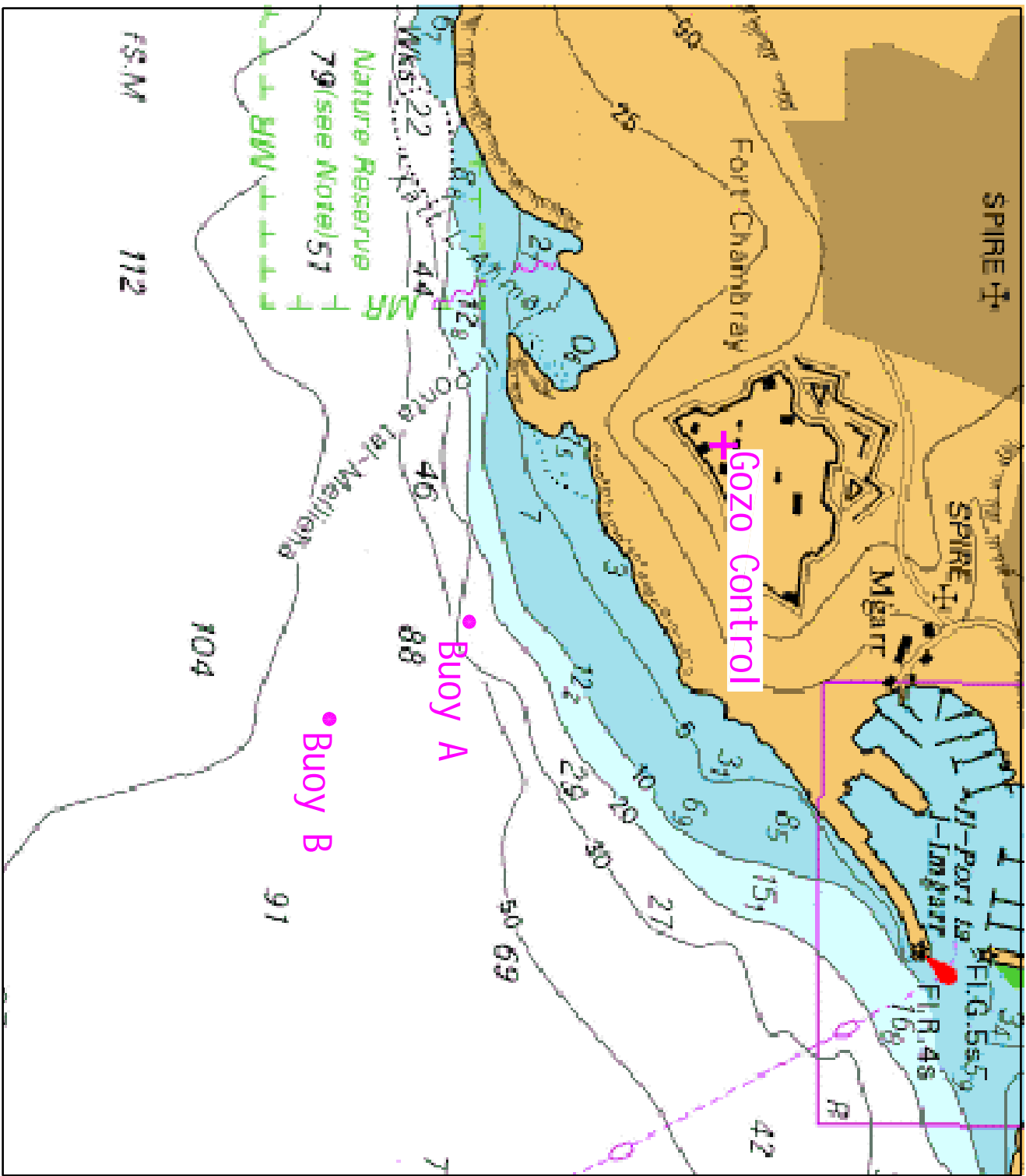
Buoy	Latitude (N)	Longitude (E)
A	36° 01'.060	014° 17'.728
B	36° 00'.927	014° 17'.844

Mariners are instructed to keep at least 500m away from the finish line.

The Classic Sailing Yachts will be departing Gozo, in parade formation, on Wednesday 5th July 2017 at 1200 hours and arriving at Marsamxett at 1600 hours (local time).

Mariners are to note the above and during the parade give a wide berth to the Classic Sailing Yachts. Any Instructions issued by Valletta Port Control (Valletta VTS) on VHF channel 12 are to be complied with.
