Fireworks Display at id-Dahla ta' tas-Sliema, Marsamxett Harbour - 2017

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta notifies Mariners that fireworks will be let off from the foreshore of Manoel Island in Sliema Creek, from four barges (4) moored in the middle of id-Dahla ta' tas-Sliema and from Manoel Island as shown on attached chart.

The fireworks displays will take place from the following places on the following dates and times:

Saturday, 1 July 2017

From point A (on Manoel Island) between 2200 hours and 2330 hours, a safety distance of 300m is required.

From the Barges between 2230 hours and 2330 hours, a safety distance of 200m is required.

From the promenade at the Ferries, between 2300 hours and 0000 hours, the safety distance is the hatched area.

Sunday, 2 July 2017


From point A (on Manoel Island) between 1200 hours and 1230 hours,
1900 hours and 2000 hours and
2030 hours and 2230 hours.

a safety distance of 300m is required.

In view of the above, mariners are informed that navigation within the mentioned areas at id-Dahla ta' tas-Sliema, Marsamxett Harbour will be prohibited during the time of fireworks. All craft moored within the indicated area (as shown on attached chart) are to be removed on the above-mentioned dates and times of the fireworks displays.

Mariners are to obey directives issued by the Valletta VTS (Valletta Port Control) on VHF channel 12, and by Police in the area.
