#### Fireworks - Feast of Balluta - 2017

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta notifies that fireworks displays in connection with the village feast of Balluta will be let off from 2 pontoons moored in the middle of St Julians Bay. The Pontoon will be moored in position "**A**" and "**B**" (as shown on attached chart) on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> July 2017 in the morning and will be removed on Monday 31<sup>st</sup> July 2017.

The dates and times of the displays are as follows:

Friday 28 <sup>th</sup> July 2017	from 2115 hours until 2300 hours
Saturday 29 <sup>th</sup> July 2017	from 2200 hours until 2330 hours
Sunday 30 <sup>th</sup> July 2017	from 1900 hours until 2300 hours

All vessels and bathers are warned to keep well clear and maintain a safe distance of not less than 60m from Pontoon "A" and 100m from pontoon "B" during the above-mentioned days and times.

Mariners are to note the above and proceed with caution and at a slow speed on the given days. The Pontoon will remain moored in position during the night.

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, will not be held responsible or liable in any manner whatsoever for any damages or expenses incurred by any person as a consequence of these fireworks' displays, including for failing to abide and comply with the above directions.
