### Diving and research survey at Marsaxlokk Harbour - 2017

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners that a diving and research survey will be carried out, within the area centered on the below position, in Marsaxlokk Harbour as shown hatched on attached chart. The field work will start on Monday 21<sup>st</sup> August 2017 and is expected to be completed by the 7<sup>th</sup> September 2017.

The centre position is as follows:

Latitude (N)	Longitude (E)
35° 49'.901	014° 33'.269

The diving and research survey will be carried out using the motor vessel "ATLANTIS II". During the survey the support vessel will be displaying the International Code of Signals Flag 'A' and 'D' as it will have restricted maneuverability.

Mariners and operators of sea craft are advised to keep a sharp lookout and proceed at slow speed while navigating in the area. They are to give the above positions and the support vessel a wide berth of at least 100 metres.

Moreover, they are requested to comply with instructions given by Marsaxlokk Port Control (Marsaxlokk VTS) on VHF Channel 14.
