The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners that fireworks display in connection with the feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel will be let off from St Gregory bastions, Valletta from point A (as shown on attached chart) on the following dates and times:-


Monday 16th July 2018 from 0800 hours until 0815 hours

Mariners are to keep a safe distance of at least 200 metres from the position indicated. They are also to maintain a wide berth and to comply with any instructions issued by Valletta Port Control (Valletta VTS) on VHF channel 12 while entering and navigating between Marsamxett Harbour and Grand Harbour.
