Round Gozo Swim - 2019

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta notifies mariners that a round Gozo swim will take place on Saturday 29th June 2019.

The five swimmers will depart from Hondoq ir-Rummien at 0300 hours and swim along the route in a clock-wise. Swim is expected to be completed by 1500 hours

The swimmers are expected to cross along the following lines at the below quoted times:

from point B to point C (outside Mgarr Harbour) between 0330 hours and 0345 hours,
from point D to point E (outside Xlendi Bay) between 0600 hours and 0730 hours and
from point F to point G between 1000 hours and 1130 hours.

Points are shown on attached chart.

Each swimmer will be accompanied by a support vessel and there will also be an Emergency Rescue Response Corps (ERRC) vessel present.

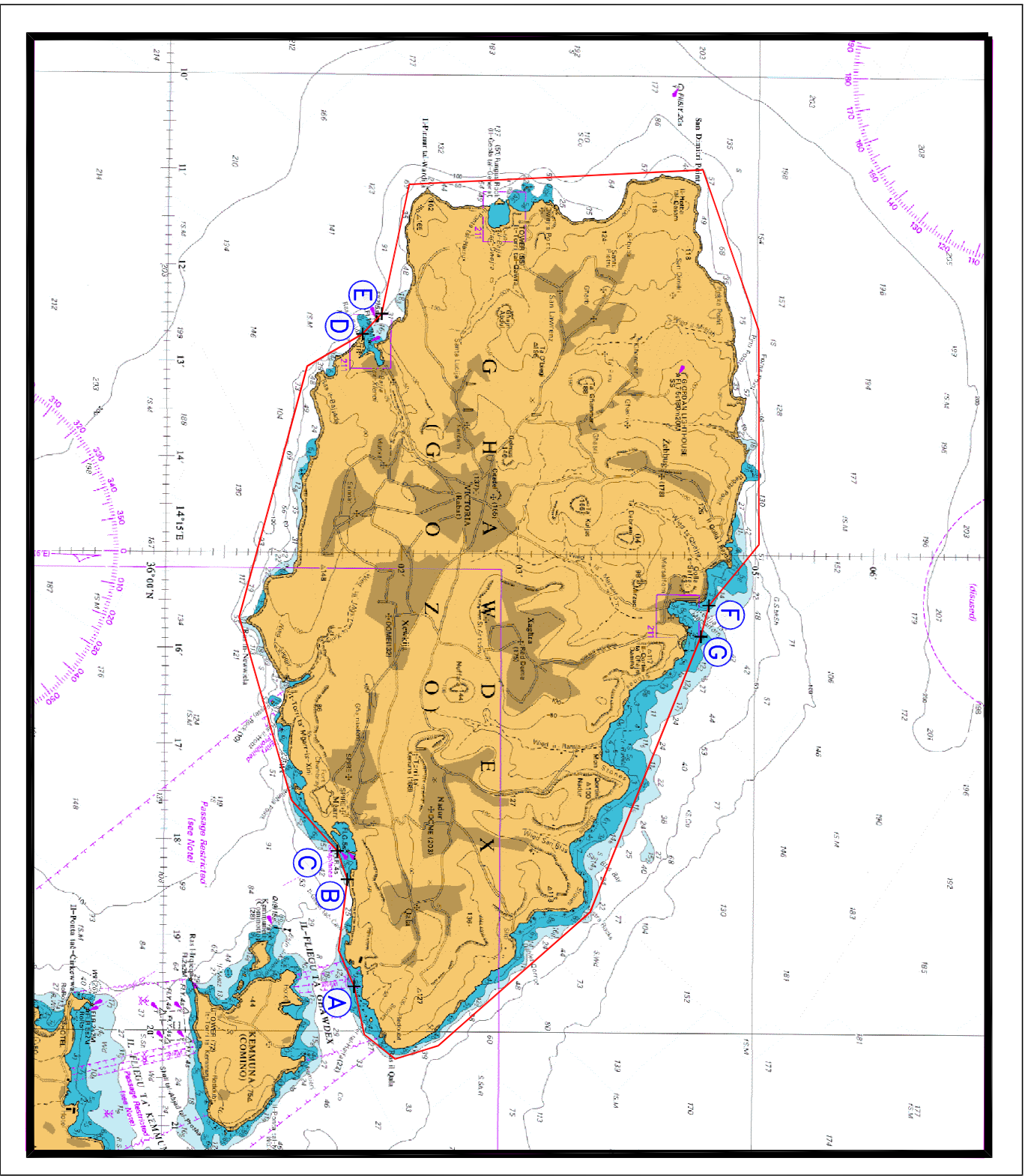
If due to inclement weather conditions the swim cannot be held on Saturday 29th June 2019, it will be held on Saturday 6th July 2019 at the same time.

Mariners are advised to keep a sharp lookout and navigate at slow speed and keep well clear of the area during the stipulated times, giving the swimmers a wide berth. They are to obey any instructions issued by Valletta Port Control (Valletta VTS) on VHF Channel 12 and Maritime Enforcement Officers on the route.
