Ghaqda Regatta Nazzjonali - Under 18 regatta - 2019

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta notifies Mariners that the Ghaqda Regatta Nazzjonali u Qdif Iehor will be organising the Under 18 regatta in Rinella Bay, Kalkara, Grand Harbour.

The regatta races will be held on Saturday 6th July 2019 from 1630 hours to 1830 hours.

Four (4) buoys will be laid in positions A, B, C and D, as indicated on attached chart, to delineate the race area.

Any vessel which is within the designated area, which includes all Rinella Bay, has to be removed by Saturday 6th July 2019 at 1000 hours.

The buoys will be laid on Saturday 6th July 2019 from 1000 hours. No vessel will be allowed to enter the designated area unless by special permission issued by Transport Malta. The buoys will be removed at the end of the races.


The positions of the buoys will be as follows:

Α	35º 53'.845	14º 31'.355
В	35º 53'.656	14º 31'.614
C	35º 53'.612	14º 31'.565
D	35º 53'.800	14º 31'.306

Mariners are advised to obey instructions given by the Valletta Port Control (Valletta VTS) on VHF channel 12 and by patrol boats and Transport Malta Enforcement Officers in the vicinity of the races.

Positions are referred to WGS 84 DATUM.
