Temporary fairway in Santa Maria Bay - Comino

Reference is made to:

Local Notice to Mariners No 009 of 2019 regarding Infrastructure Malta works in various localities in Malta and Gozo.

Notice to Mariners No 08 of 2017 regarding Fairway established at Santa Marija Bay, Comino.

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners that due to infrastructural works, with immediate effect, a temporary fairway has been established at Santa Marija Bay – Comino.

The temporary fairway established is the imaginary line A to E to D on one side and the imaginary line B to C on the other. Flashing yellow buoys have been laid at these points (as shown on the attached chart).

Fairway mentioned in Notice to Mariners No 08 of 2017 is hereby temporarily removed.

Owners of vessels are hereby being instructed that no vessel is to be left unattended within Santa Marija Bay. A floating pontoon has been placed along the northeast side of the slipway (shown in red on attached chart).

This pontoon is to be used only for un/loading operations.

Area next to the pontoon (shown hatched on attached chart) is to be kept clear at all times.


