Fireworks Display from a Barge and pontoons Moored at “Il-Qala tal-Ghazzenin, il-Bajja ta’ San Pawl il-Bahar”

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta notifies mariners that firework displays in connection with the feast of Our Lady of Sorrows, St Paul’s Bay, will be let off from a barge and pontoons moored in the position as shown on the attached chart.

The pontoons will be moored in position on Wednesday 24th July 2019 after 0900 hours.

The barge will be moored in position on Thursday 25th July 2019 after 0900 hours.

The barge and pontoons will be left in moored in position and will be lit during the night

The dates and times of the displays are as follows:

Friday, 26 th July 2019	from 0800 hours until 0810 hours from 1200 hours until 1220 hours from 2130 hours until 2230 hours
Saturday 27 th July 2019	from 0800 hours until 0810 hours from 1145 hours until 1215 hours from 1800 hours until 1900 hours from 2200 hours until 2330 hours
Sunday 28 th July 2019	from 0800 hours until 0830 hours from 1200 hours until 1220 hours from 1900 hours until 2030 hours

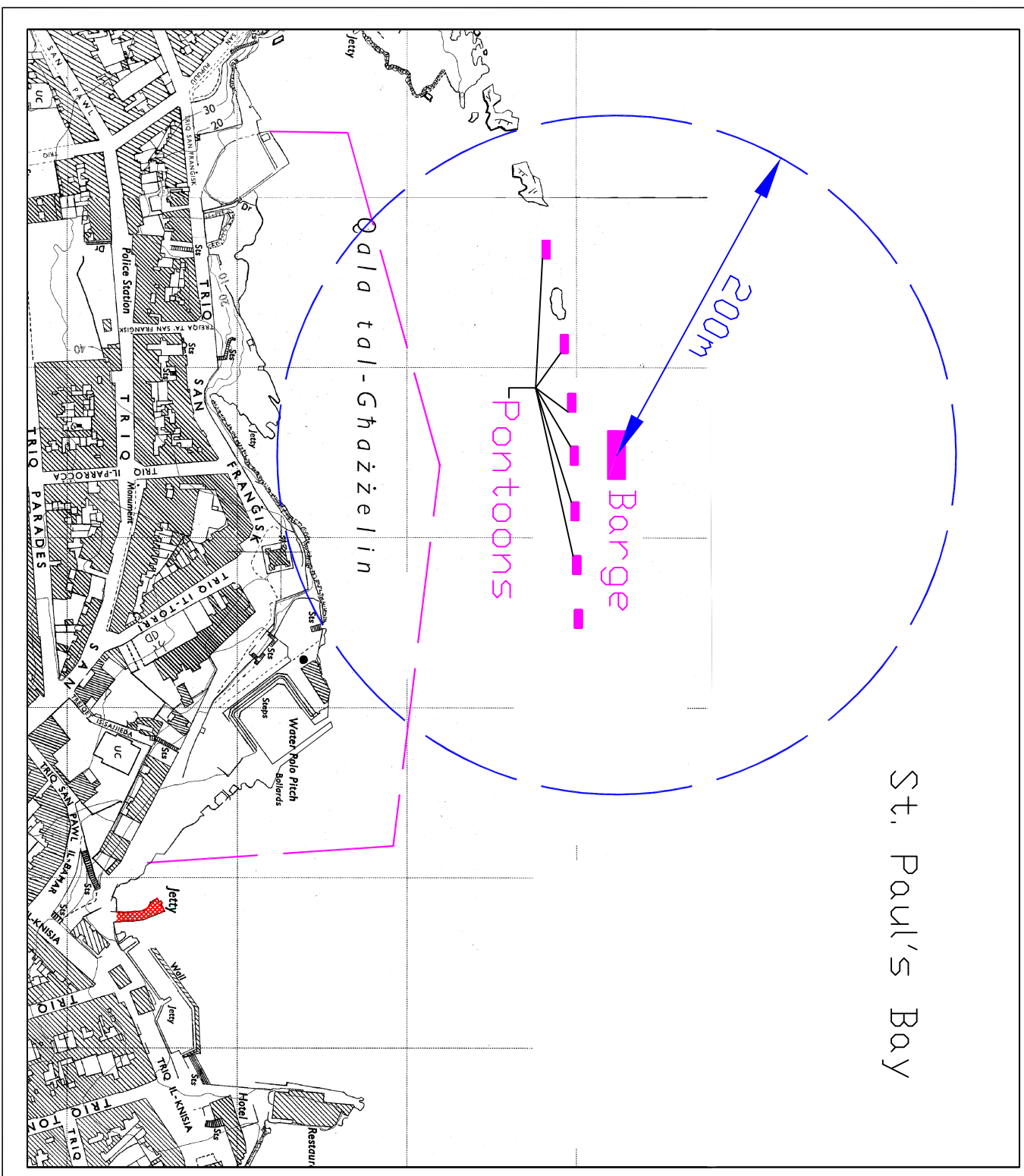
Fireworks will be loaded on their racks on the jetty (shown in red on attached chart), they will then be loaded on to boats to be transported to the barge and pontoons. This work will be done on Friday 26th July 2019 between 1800 hours and 2200 hours. Mariners are informed that during these times the jetty cannot be used and no vessel will be allowed to stay alongside the jetty.

All vessels and bathers are warned to keep well clear of the barge and pontoons and maintain a safe distance of at least 200 metres during the dates and times of the displays.

Vessels moored within 200 metres from the barge are to be removed and kept clear during the days and times of the display. The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta will accept no Liabilities whatsoever for any vessels that are left lying in the area on the above mentioned dates and times.
