Fireworks - Feast of Balluta - 2019

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta notifies that a fireworks display in connection with the village feast of Balluta will be let off from 3 pontoons moored in the middle of St Julians Bay.

The Pontoon will be moored in position "A", "B" and "C" (as shown on attached chart) on Friday 26th July 2019 in the morning and will be removed on Monday 29th July 2019.

The dates and times of the displays are as follows:

Friday 26 th July 2019	from 2115 hours until 2300 hours .
Saturday 27 th July 2019	from 2200 hours until 2330 hours.
Sunday 28 th July 2019	from 1200 hours until 1215 hours and
	from 1900 hours until 2300 hours.

All vessels and bathers are warned to keep well clear and maintain a safe distance of not less than 60m from Pontoon "A", 100m from pontoon "B" and 150m from pontoon "C" during the above-mentioned days and times.

Mariners are to note the above and proceed with caution and at a slow speed on the given days.

The Pontoon will remain moored in position during the night and will have flashing lights.


