Fireworks Displays – Feast of St. Anne Marsascala

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta notifies that fireworks displays will be let off from pontoons moored at the inner part of Marsascala Bay. The pontoons will be moored between the two points A and B as shown on attached chart.

The pontoons will be put in position on Saturday 27th July 2019 at 1100 hours and will be removed on Sunday 28th July 2019 after the display.

Fireworks will be let off on the following dates and times:

	Saturday 27 th July 2019	from 2300 hours until 2330 hours.
and	Sunday 28 th July 2019	from 2145 hours until 2215 hours.

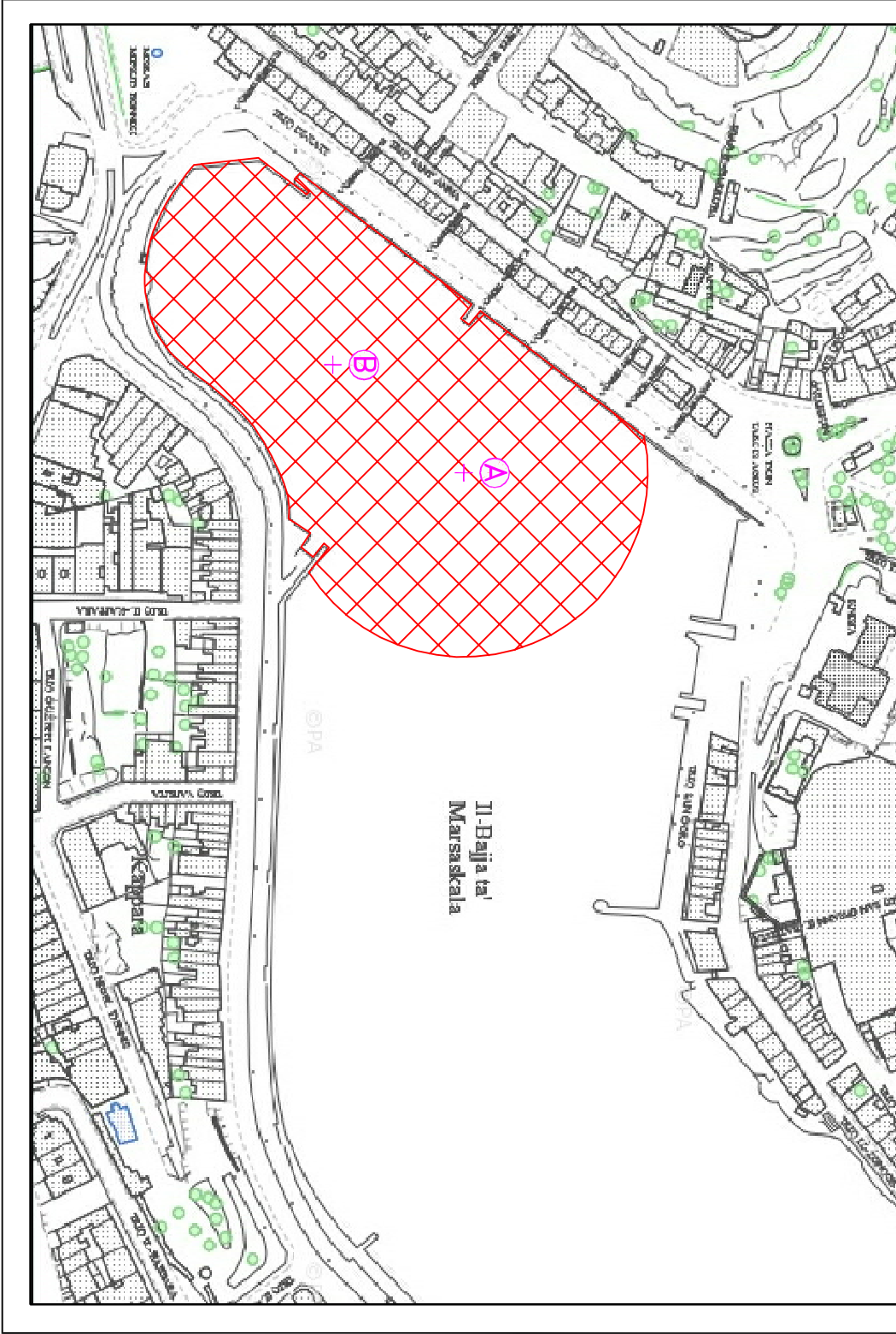
Vessels within the area hatched in red, on attached chart, are to be removed. All vessel operators and bathers are warned to keep clear from the pontoons during the above-mentioned days and at all times while the pontoons are in position.

All vessels navigating in the innermost part of Marsascala Bay are to proceed with caution and at a slow speed, on both given days, and give a wide berth to the pontoons.
