OTILLO - Swimrun World Series 2019

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta notifies mariners that the OTILLO Swimrun World Series 2019 will be held between Saturday 23rd and Sunday 24th November 2019. There will be safety boats in each individual swim at all time.

On Saturday 23rd November 2019 the Spirit Malta and the Experience Malta races will be held, starting and finishing at II-Bajja tal-Mixquqa (Golden Sands). There will be approximately 200 participants.

The swimming part of these races will follow the route (as shown on attached chart 1) and will be as follows:

Swim between points	Start and finish time of the individual swim
from A to B	1100 hours and 1155 hours,
from C to D	1055 hours and 1220 hours,
from E to F	1105 hours and 1245 hours,
from G to H	1145 hours and 1320 hours and
from C to B	1225 hours and 1430 hours.

On Sunday 24th November 2019 the World Series Malta race will be held, starting in Valletta and finishing at II-Bajja tal-Mixquqa (Golden Sands). There will be approximately 300 participants.

The swimming part of this race will follow the route (as shown on attached chart 2) and will be as follows:

Swim between points	Start and finish time of the individual swim
from A to B	0800 hours and 0830 hours,
from C to D	0810 hours and 0845 hours,
from E to F	0820 hours and 0910 hours,
from G to H	0830 hours and 0920 hours,
from I to J	0850 hours and 1030 hours,
from K to L	0915 hours and 1110 hours,









from M to N	0935 hours and 1200 hours,
from O to P	1015 hours and 1330 hours,
from Q to R	1045 hours and 1400 hours,
from S to T	1100 hours and 1430 hours,
from U to V	1120 hours and 1500 hours,
from W to X	1150 hours and 1550 hours and
from Y to Z	1205 hours and 1640 hours.

Mariners are advised to keep a sharp lookout and navigate at slow speed, they are to keep well clear of the areas during the stipulated date and times, giving the swimmers and support vessels a wide berth. They are to obey any instructions issued by Valletta Port Control (Valletta VTS) on VHF channel 12 and maritime enforcement assets in the area.


