Fireworks - Feast of St Paul Shipwreck - Valletta – 2020

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta notifies Mariners that in connection with the Titular Feast of St Paul's Shipwreck, aerial fireworks display will be let off from the foreshore at il-Ponta ta' Sant' Jiermu (point A) and ground fireworks from on the bastion next to il-Ponta ta' L-Imgerbeb (point B) in Valletta from approximately the following position:

	LATITUDE (N)	LONGITUDE (E)
A	35° 54'.163	14° 31'.226
B	35° 53'.892	14° 31'.089

The dates and times of the fireworks from the above positions are as follows:

From point A:

Sunday 9th February 2020 from 2100 hours to 2230 hours.
Monday 10th February 2020 from 0800 hours to 0815 hours,
from 1200 hours to 1215 hours and
from 1745 hours to 1930 hours.

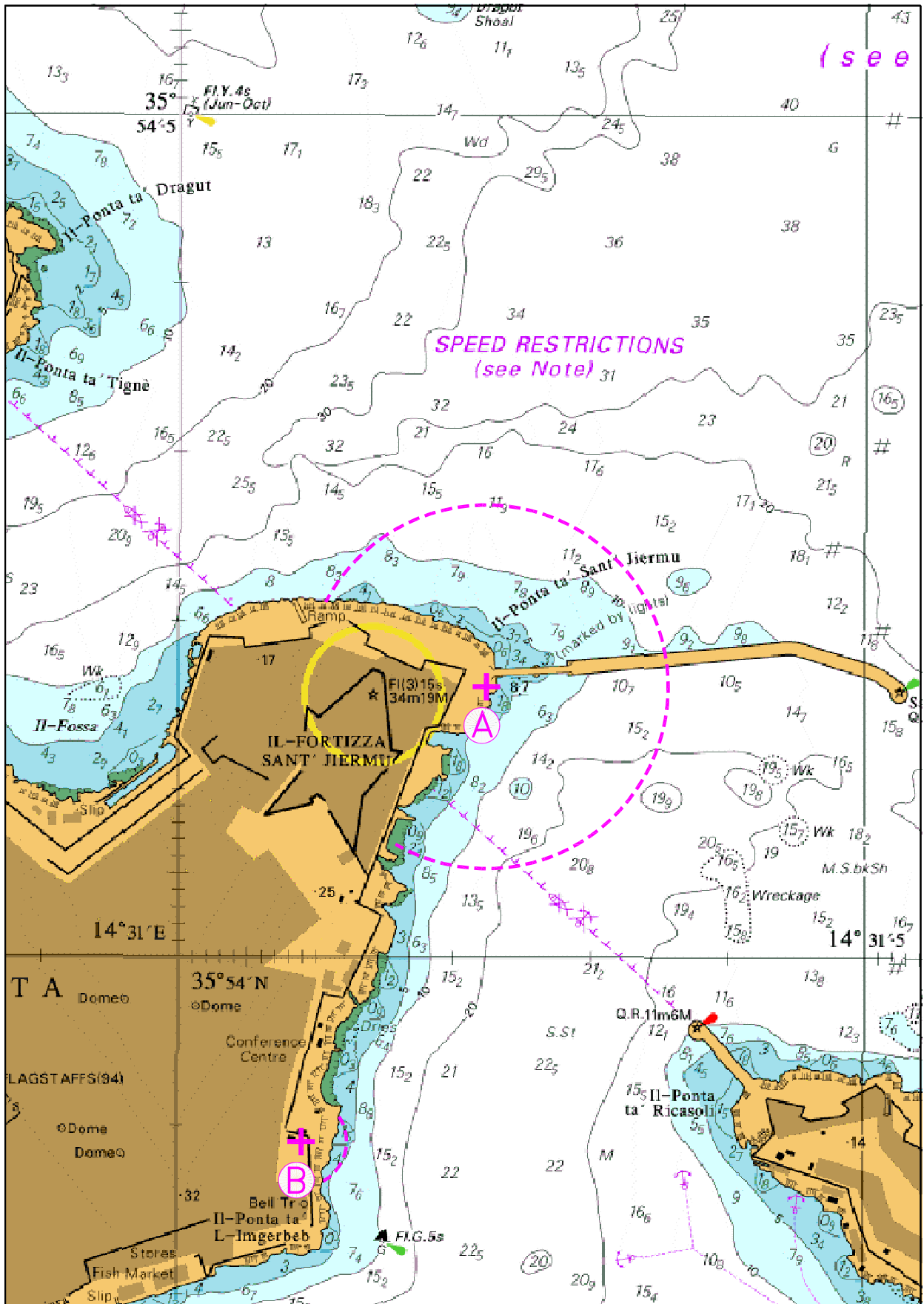
From point B:

Sunday 9th February 2020 from 2230 hours to 2300 hours

Mariners are to note the above, give the position indicated a wide berth and a safe distance from point A of at least 200m and from point B of at least 50m (as shown on attached chart). They are further instructed to contact Valletta Port Control (Valletta VTS) on VHF channel 12 when navigating in and/or out of the Grand Harbour and Marsamxett Harbour on the above dates and times. Any instructions issued by Valletta Port Control (Valletta VTS) are to be complied with.
