Further to Local Notice to Mariners No. 012 of 2019 Regarding Dredging at Mgarr Harbour - Gozo

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners and the general public that further to Local Notice to Mariners Nos. 012 of 2019 regarding Dredging at Mgarr Harbour – Gozo, diving surveys will be carried out within the area shown hatched in red on attached:

The diving surveys will take place from Monday 25th to Friday 29th May 2020 and from Monday 1st to Friday 5th June 2020, between 0800 hours and 1600 hours.

The surveys will be carried out by scuba divers and will be accompanied by a support vessel which will be displaying the international code of Signals flag “A”.

Due to the above there is to be no vessel movements within the said area on the above mentioned dates and times.

Mariners are to keep out of the area and advised to keep a sharp lookout, navigate with caution and very slow speed (no wake) when navigating close to the indicated area. They are to comply with instructions given by Valletta Port Control (Valletta VTS) on Channel 12 and any enforcement personnel on site.

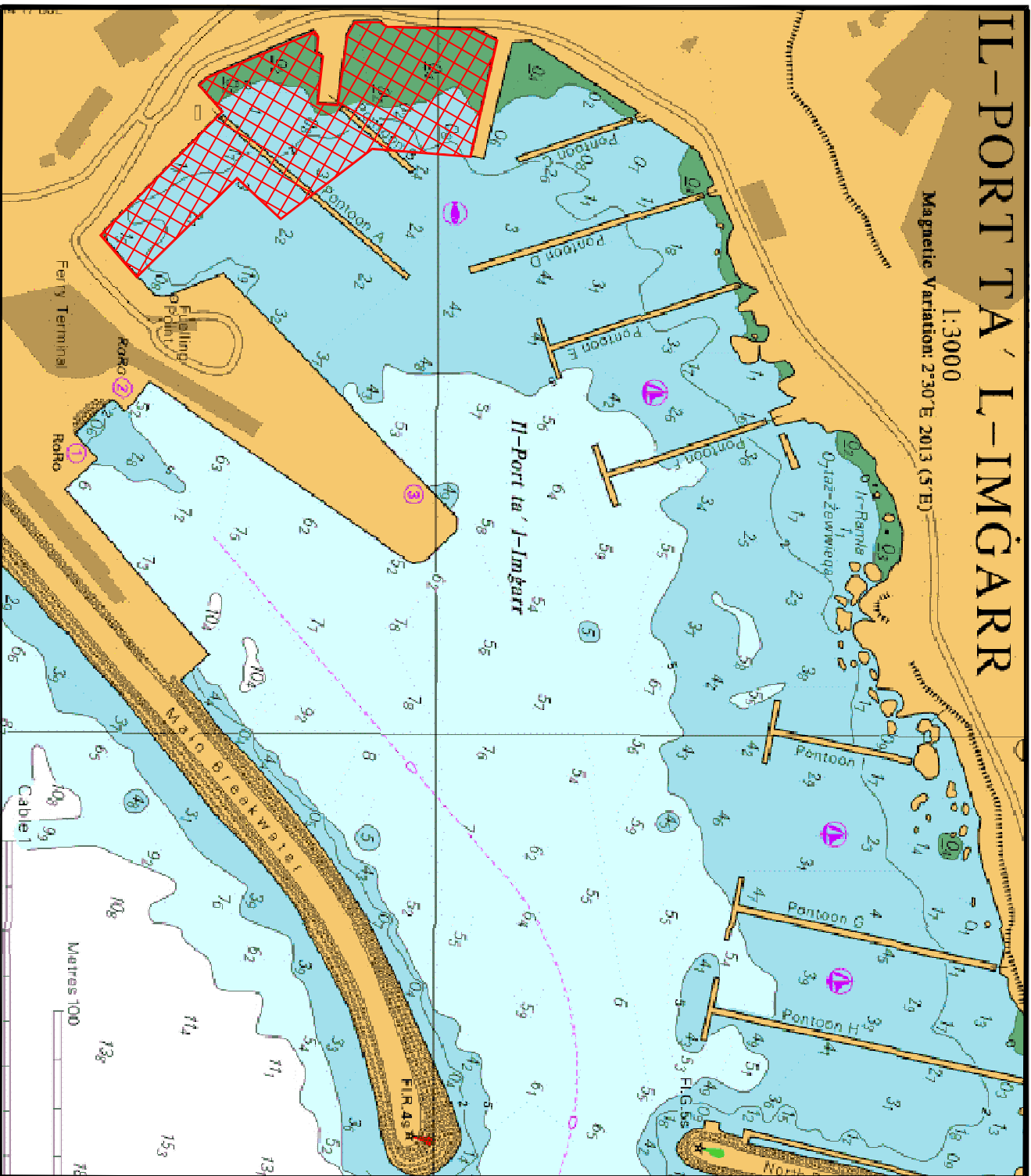
