### Fireworks Display - Madonna tal-Karmnu, Gzira feast

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta notifies Mariners that fireworks display will be let off from the foreshore in Sliema Creek, centred in Positions A, as shown on the attached chart.

Position	Latitude (N)	Longitude (E)
А	35º 54'.319	014º 30'.321

The fireworks will be let off as follows:

Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> July 2021 between 1800 hours and 1830 hours and Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> July 2021 between 1915 hours and 1945 hours.

In view of the above, mariners are informed that navigation within 200 meters from the above position A in Marsamxett Harbour will be prohibited during the time of fireworks.

All craft moored within 200m from point A (as shown on the attached chart) are to be removed on the above-mentioned date and times of the fireworks displays. The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta will accept no Liabilities whatsoever for any vessels that are left lying in the area on the above-mentioned date and times

Mariners are to obey any instructions issued on VHF channels 12 and/or 16 by Valletta VTS and Enforcement agencies in the area.


