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## Yachting Malta BSC International Regatta 2022

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta would like to notify mariners that the Birzebbuga Sailing Club shall be holding the Yachting Malta BSC International Regatta 2022 between Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> February and Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> February 2022.

Races shall be held between 0900 hours and 1700 hours (local time) on all days.


Class races shall be held over two (2) adjacent upwind / downwind courses, centred in the selected sailing area depending on the prevailing weather conditions. See attached chart showing areas A, B and C.

The courses, around which the competitors shall have to sail, shall be defined by orange inflatable marks (waypoints) of about 1.5 meters in height.

Races will be held when no merchant vessel traffic is scheduled to enter or depart from the Malta Freeport Terminals.

Masters of all craft, not directly involved in this event, are asked to keep clear of the racing area, especially at each of the turning marks. All mariners are to observe any instructions that may be given by the Race Organisers safety crafts and on VHF Channels 14 and/or 16 by Marsaxlokk VTS.
