- Be the registered owner of a heavy-duty motor vehicle which has been retrofitted with a diesel particulate filter (DPF) and selective catalytic reduction (SCR) system;

The De Minimis² state aid rules shall apply in the case of applications submitted by undertakings or voluntary organisations having an economic activity.

This form is applicable for vehicles registered after the 1st of January 2022. The scheme closes on the 31st of December 2022 unless the available budget is exhausted before.

Filing your application DOES NOT automatically entitle you to receive the grant.

Grant details

Subject to the conditions stipulated in this document, a grant of ten thousand Euro (€10,000) will be paid to the registered owners of heavy-duty motor vehicles which are retrofitted with a DPF device and an SCR system resulting in a substantial reduction of NOx emissions.

4. Retention period
