Dredging work in the inner part of the Grand Harbour - 2022

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners that dredging works will be carried out in the inner part of the Grand Harbour – Valletta.

The dredging works will be carried out using the vessel "Grane R" which will be restricted in her ability to manoeuvre and will be displaying the appropriate lights and shapes in compliance with the Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea (COLREGS).

Dredging works will be carried out between Saturday 16th July 2022 and Monday 18th July 2022, in the following areas:

- Deep Water Quay (area A)
- Ras Ħanżir (area B)
- Bridge Wharf (area C)
- Fuel Wharf (area D)
- Coal Wharf (area E),
- Church Wharf (area F)

Dredging work next to the Southwest extension (area G) will be carried out between:

- Monday 8th August 2022 and Wednesday 10th August 2022
- Thursday 1st September 2022 and Saturday 3rd September 2022
- Sunday 25th September 2022 and Monday 26th September 2022.

The dredging works will be carried out day and night.

In line with the dredging operation a number of vessels will be required and instructed to shift. The shifting of vessels and the dredging itself will be coordinated by Valletta VTS, the Traffic Management Unit (TMU) at Transport Malta and the contractor on site.










Masters and operators of vessels are advised to keep a sharp lookout, navigate with caution, and at slow speed and to give the above vessel "Grane R" a wide berth of at least 150m.

Instructions given on VHF Channel 12 and/or 16 by Valletta VTS are to be complied with.
