Fireworks Display - Feast of St. Joseph - Kalkara - 2022

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners that fireworks will be let off from Kalkara Creek (point A), Rinella Bay (point B) and from a barge moored off Bighi (point Y), as shown on attached chart, from the approximate positions on the dates and times as follows:

In Kalkara Creek from the area known as "taht is-swar tal-Posta ta' Kastilja u t'Aragona" (point A):

Monday 11 th July 2022	from 0800 hours till 0810 hours, from 1200 hours till 1210 hours and from 1930 hours till 1950 hours.
Wednesday 13 th July 2022	from 0800 hours till 0810 hours and from 1200 hours till 1210 hours.
Thursday 14 th July 2022	from 0800 hours till 0810 hours,
	from 1200 hours till 1210 hours and from 2030 hours till 2200 hours.
Friday 15 th July 2022	from 0800 hours till 0810 hours,
	from 1200 hours till 1210 hours and from 2130 hours till 2300 hours.
Saturday 16 th July 2022	from 0900 hours till 1000 hours,
	from 1200 hours till 1220 hours,
	from 1800 hours till 1900 hours and from 2000 hours till 2330 hours.
Sunday 17 th July 2022	from 0800 hours till 0810 hours,
,	from 1200 hours till 1220 hours and
	from 1900 hours till 2300 hours.









In Rinella Bay, Kalkara (point B):

Sunday 10th July 2022 Friday 15th July 2022

from 1930 hours till 2030 hours, from 0800 hours till 0810 hours, from 1200 hours till 1210 hours and from 2100 hours till 2200 hours.

From the barge "45" moored off Bighi (point Y)

Saturday 16th July 2022 from 2200 hours till midnight.


Mariners are to note that the barge "45" will be moored at Kalkara Quay on Wednesday 13th and Thursday 14th July 2022. It will then be towed to point Y on Friday 15th July and will remain in position up to Monday 18th July 2022.

In view of the above, mariners are to give a wide berth of 100 meters from the area known as "taht s-swar tal-Posta ta' Kastilja u t' Aragona" in Kalkara Creek (point A), they are also to give a wide berth of 200 meters from Rinella Bay, Kalkara (point B) and from the barge off Bighi (point Y), as shown on the attached chart.

All Vessels within 100 metres radius from point A and 200 metres radius from point B are to be removed on the above-mentioned dates and times of the displays.

All mariners are to comply with any instructions given on VHF Channel 12 and/or 16, by Valletta VTS and by any Enforcement Personnel on site.
