## Fireworks Display in St. Julian's Bay – Feast of St. Julian's - 2022

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners that firework displays in connection with the feast of St Julian's will be let off from the breakwater (known as II-Pont tal-Banis) and from 6 pontoons moored in St Julian's Bay.

The fireworks display will be let of from both the breakwater (known as il-Pont tal-Banis) point A and the 6 pontoons which will be moored along the imaginary line between points B and C, as shown on the attached chart.

The firework displays will take place on the following dates and times:

Saturday 27 <sup>th</sup> August 2022	1200 hours till 1215 hours and 2145 hours till 2245 hours.
Sunday 28 <sup>th</sup> August 2022	1200 hours till 1215 hours and 2100 hours till 2130 hours.

The pontoons will be moored in position, on each day, from 1100 hours up to 1300 hours and later from 1900 hours until 1 hour after the displays are completed.

All vessels and bathers are warned to keep well clear and maintain a safe distance of not less than 60 metres from the breakwater (known as II-Pont tal-Banis) and 150m form the pontoons. Any vessels moored within these areas are to be removed by 1900 hours and returned after the displays finish, on both days.










Mariners are to obey instructions and directions given on VHF channel 12 and/or 16 by Valletta VTS and any Enforcement Officials in the area.
