## Fireworks Display from the Foreshore off II-Fortizza Manoel – 3 September 2022

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners that a 5-minute fireworks display will be let off from the foreshore of II-Fortizza Manoel on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2022. The display will be centred at Point A (as shown on the attached chart) in the approximate following position:

LATITUDE (N) LONGITUDE (E)

A 35°54'.223 14°30'.469


The fireworks display will take place between 2200 hours and 2230 hours.

In view of the above, mariners are advised to keep 150 metres away from point A on the above-mentioned date and time.

Any boats berthed or anchored within the area shown on the attached chart are to be removed during the above-mentioned date and time. The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, will accept no liabilities whatsoever, for any vessels that are not removed from the area on the above-mentioned date and time.

All mariners are to comply with any instructions given on VHF Channel 12 and/or 16, by Valletta VTS and by any enforcement officers on site.
