Diving survey with handheld video camera at II-Bajja ta' Marsaxlokk

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners and owners of vessels that a diving survey with handheld video camera at II-Bajja ta' Marsaxlokk.

The diving survey will be held between Tuesday 20th September 2022 and Saturday 24th September 2022, within the area formed by joining the imaginary lines between the points A, B, C, D and the intermediate coastline, as shown in red on the attached chart.

The actual survey will last 1 day and will be held between 0900 hours and 1400 hours.



The survey will be carried out by scuba divers who will be accompanied by the support vessel "S25214" which will be displaying the International Code of Signals flag "A", when diving operations are being carried out.

A safety zone of 100m round the support vessel "S25214" is to be kept during the surveys.

Masters and operators of vessels are advised to keep a sharp lookout, proceed with caution and at slow speed when navigating in the above indicated areas. They are to comply with instructions given on VHF Channel 14 and/or 16 by Marsaxlokk VTS.
