Maintenance works on the slipways at II-Fekruna and Ix-Xemxija in II-Bajja ta' San Pawl

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners that maintenance works will be carried out on the slipways at II-Fekruna and Ix-Xemxija in II-Bajja ta' San Pawl.

The works will start on Tuesday 4th April 2023 and should be completed by Saturday 8th April 2023.

A silt curtain may be laid on a radius of 20m from point A at II-Fekruna and on a radius of 20m from point B at Ix-Xemxija, as shown on the attached chart.


These works will also be carried out by scuba divers who will be displaying the International Code of Signals flag "A", while works are being carried out.

Due to the above, the slipways mentioned above will not be accessible while the works are being carried out.

Mariners and owners of vessels are to proceed at very low speed (no wake) when navigating close to the area and are to co-operate with the contractor on site.

All mariners are to comply with any instructions given on VHF Channel 12 and/or 16, by Valletta VTS and by any Enforcement Personnel on site.
