## MEDIAS 2023 Survey and Research between Malta and Sicily

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners that acoustic survey and research will be carried out between Malta and Sicily.

Weather permitting the survey/research is planned to commence on Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2023 and be completed by Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2023 and will be working day and night within the area A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H I and J.

Part of the work consists of the survey vessel towing a pelagic net and sometimes she will also be stationary therefore she will be restricted in her ability to manoeuvre.

The survey vessel shall exhibit the appropriate lights and shape signals in accordance with the Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at sea. 1972 (COLREGS) and with the International Code of Signals.

Mariners are instructed to navigate with caution when the above-mentioned vessel is sighted and maintain a safe distance of 0.50 Nautical Miles from the vessels.





They are to observe any instructions given on VHF channel 69 and /or 16 by Malta Coastal Station (Malta VTS) and on VHF channel 12 by Valletta VTS when crossing the channel between Sicily and Malta.
