Fireworks - Feast of Balluta - 2023

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies that in connection with the feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel at Balluta Bay fireworks will be let off from a pontoon moored in the middle of St Julians Bay.

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies that a firework display in connection with the village feast of Balluta will be let off from a pontoon moored in the middle of St Julians Bay.

The pontoon will be moored in position "A" (as shown on the attached chart) on Friday 28th July 2023 in the morning and will be removed on Monday 31st July 2023.

POSITION LATITUDE (N) LONGITUDE (E)
A 35° 54'.966 014° 29'.682

The dates and times of the displays are as follows:

Friday 28th July 2023 from 2100 hours until 2230 hours .
Saturday 29th July 2023 from 2030 hours until 2330 hours and Sunday 30th July 2023 from 1930 hours until 2230 hours.

All vessels and bathers are warned to keep well clear and maintain a safe distance of not less than 75m from pontoon "A", during the above-mentioned days and times.

The pontoon will remain moored in position during the night and will have flashing lights.

Transport Malta will accept no liability whatsoever for any damage caused by the firework displays to any vessel and her ancillary equipment, whether such vessel and her ancillary equipment are left within the indicated area, or outside such area.

All mariners are to note the above and comply with any instructions given on VHF Channel 12 and/or 16, by Valletta VTS and by any Enforcement Personnel on site.
