Fireworks Displays in St. Julians Bay – San Girgor (Sliema)

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies that firework displays in connection with the feast of St Gregory will be let off from the jetty at point A (as shown on the attached chart) on the following dates and time:

POSITION	LATITUDE (N)	LONGITUDE (E)
А	35° 54'.931	014° 29'.818
Friday 1 st September 2023		from 2145 hours to 2150 hours,
Saturday 2 nd September 2023		from 2235 hours to 2250 hours and
Sunday 3 rd September 2023		from 2100 hours to 2130 hours.


All vessels and bathers are warned to keep clear and maintain a minimum distance of not less than 100 meters from the Jetty (as shown on the attached chart) during the abovementioned displays.

Vessels moored within 100 metres from point A (as shown on the attached chart) are to be removed and the area kept clear during the displays.

Transport Malta will accept no liability whatsoever for any damage caused by the firework displays to any vessel and her ancillary equipment, whether such vessel and her ancillary equipment are left within the safety zones mentioned, or outside such safety zone, from the point from which the fireworks are let off.

Mariners are to obey instructions and directions given on VHF channel 12 and/or 16 by Valletta VTS and any Enforcement Officials in the area.
