## Diving survey (Benthic) within II-Bajja ta' Marsaxlokk – October 2023

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners and owners of vessels that diving (Benthic) surveys will be held within II-Bajja ta'Marsaxlokk.

The diving survey which will be held on any day between Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2023 and Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> November 2023, within the area formed by joining the points A, B, C and D and the area formed by joining the points X, Y and the intermediate coastline, as shown on the attached chart.


During the diving survey the scuba divers will be accompanied by a support vessel which will be displaying the International Code of Signals flag "A".

A safety zone of 50m round the survey area is to be kept during the survey.

Masters and operators of vessels are advised to keep a sharp lookout, proceed with caution and at slow speed when navigating in the vicinity of the above indicated area.

They are to comply with instructions given on VHF Channel 14 and/or 16 by Marsaxlokk VTS.
